









39 USCG Maritime Coverage







#### 9 U. S. Army Corps Coverage





#### FY07 DOT Funding Issue

- Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) / DOT requested \$0 funds for the FY07 NDGPS budget.
- FRA relinquished sponsorship of Program.
- FY07 routine operating expenses are supported by FY06 reimbursable funds.
  - New construction of Sites Has Been Halted
  - Katrina funded projects (\$1.7M)
    - Relocate Mobile Point, AL to Eglin AFB, FL
    - Construct Card Sound, FL







#### Research and Innovative Technology Administration

#### (RITA)

- Agreed to sponsor NDGPS for FY08 as a stop-gap measure.
- Independent Assessment of NDGPS has been awarded by RITA.
  - Interim report was received by DOT
- Requested FY08 NDGPS Budget
  - \$5M in President's Budget for O&M





## USCG Letter to DOT 13 July 2006

### If FRA (now RITA) does not identify a sustainable long-term funding strategy by FY08:

- CG will formally initiate termination of involvement in the NDGPS MOA.
  - Maintain Maritime portion (MDGPS) as standalone system.
  - CG will work with DOT to commence decommissioning of inland sites.
  - Initiate formal public notification to the required offices to terminate signals.
- Transition Planning is in progress





## Why doesn't the CG fund the Inland Sites?

- No Authority/Requirement for land navigation
  - 14 USC Section 81
    - The Coast Guard "May establish, maintain, and operate aids to <u>maritime</u> navigation..."
  - Interagency Memorandum of Agreement
    - USCG, FRA, FHWA, and USACE
  - Economy Act Transaction
    - Servicing agency is funded on Reimbursable Basis





#### Research and Innovative Technology Administration

#### Published Status Report

#### Available on NAVCEN Website

- DOT is currently assessing the continued need for NDGPS, and is searching for agencies to share sponsorship.
- \$5M requested by RITA for FY08, again with no funding for expansion, while conducting the system assessment.
- In this interim period, the Coast Guard will continue to operate and maintain existing sites as funding levels permit.
- FY09 funding levels and sources have not yet been identified.
- The Maritime DGPS, which is funded by the USCG, will continue operations regardless of the results of the DOT NDGPS system assessment.





#### Resource Proposal (FY09)

- In the event that DOT does not fund NDGPS in FY09...
- 12 DOT Funded Sites identified to preserve Maritime coverage.
- Requests \$543K of O&M funding to maintain Maritime portion of DGPS.










### 12 DOT Funded Sites identified to
